

**Going Beyond Travel Trip Itinerary  
For The Best of Cincinnati  
October 30 - November 2, 2008**

**Thursday, October 30** – We begin pick ups at 8 AM to begin our drive to Cincinnati. There will be a lunch stop along the way. In the evening we will arrive at **The Comfort Inn, in Harrison, Ohio**, about 20 miles from downtown Cincinnati. (phone 513-367-9666) There is an **indoor pool** at this hotel.

**Friday, October 31** – After breakfast at the hotel we take a 20 minute drive to downtown Cincinnati to the **National Underground Railroad Freedom Center**. Take a sobering look at the role of slavery and the struggle for freedom that caused the civil war for America. We will participate in a guided tour, lunch will follow and then there is time to see more of the museum and the gift shop.

The late afternoon will be spent exploring the **downtown Cincinnati area: Fountain Square, the Purple People Bridge, and The Bicentennial Commons at Sawyer Point and Yeatman's Cove**. We will show you **William Howard Taft's boyhood home, the Rankin House (an abolitionist and Presbyterian Minister) and Harriet Beecher Stowe's house (creator of "Uncle Tom's Cabin")**.

A **pizza party** is planned for the evening and relaxing by the pool.

**Saturday, November 1** – After breakfast at the hotel, we head to the Ohio River. Gather aboard for a **sightseeing and entertaining Captain's buffet lunch and Riverboat ride**. Hopefully the spectacular fall colors will still take our breath away on this picturesque tour.

After the boat ride, we will have a million gallons of fun at the **Newport Aquarium**. Come meet the penguins, gators, sharks, frogs and jellyfish. Relax at the theatre showing the **Wonder of an Underwater World**.

Spend some time walking along the river and shopping at **Newport on the Levee**. If weather permits, there may even be some live outdoor music.

**Sunday, November 2-** Sleep in, we **turn our clocks back to standard time!** Following breakfast, we pack up and begin our drive Northwest.

We stop in the Indianapolis area for an **Easley Winery tour**. See the process and sample some award winning Indiana wine! We will also drive through the downtown area to show you the **RCA dome**, where the Indianapolis Colts play and the World famous **Indianapolis Speedway!** A meal stop is planned along the way home.

We hope to **arrive in the Milwaukee area around 6:30 PM**.
